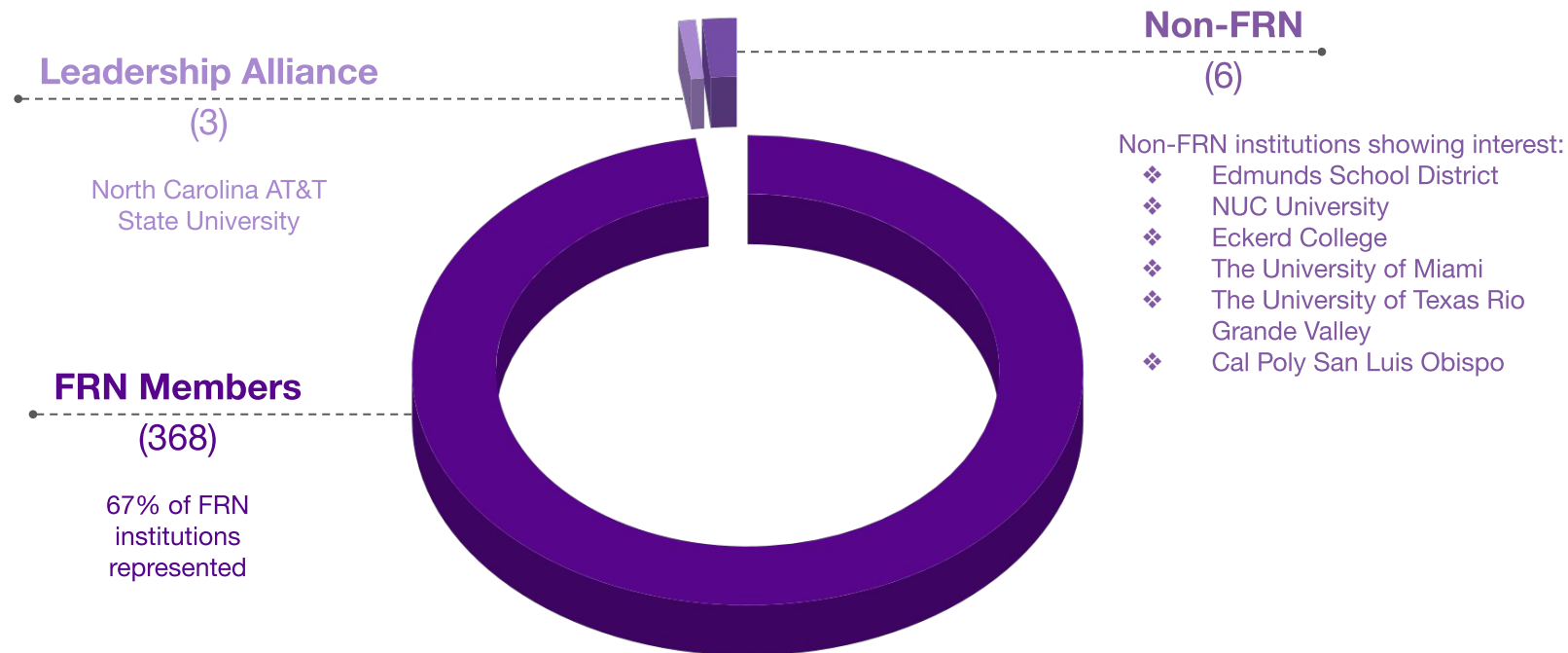

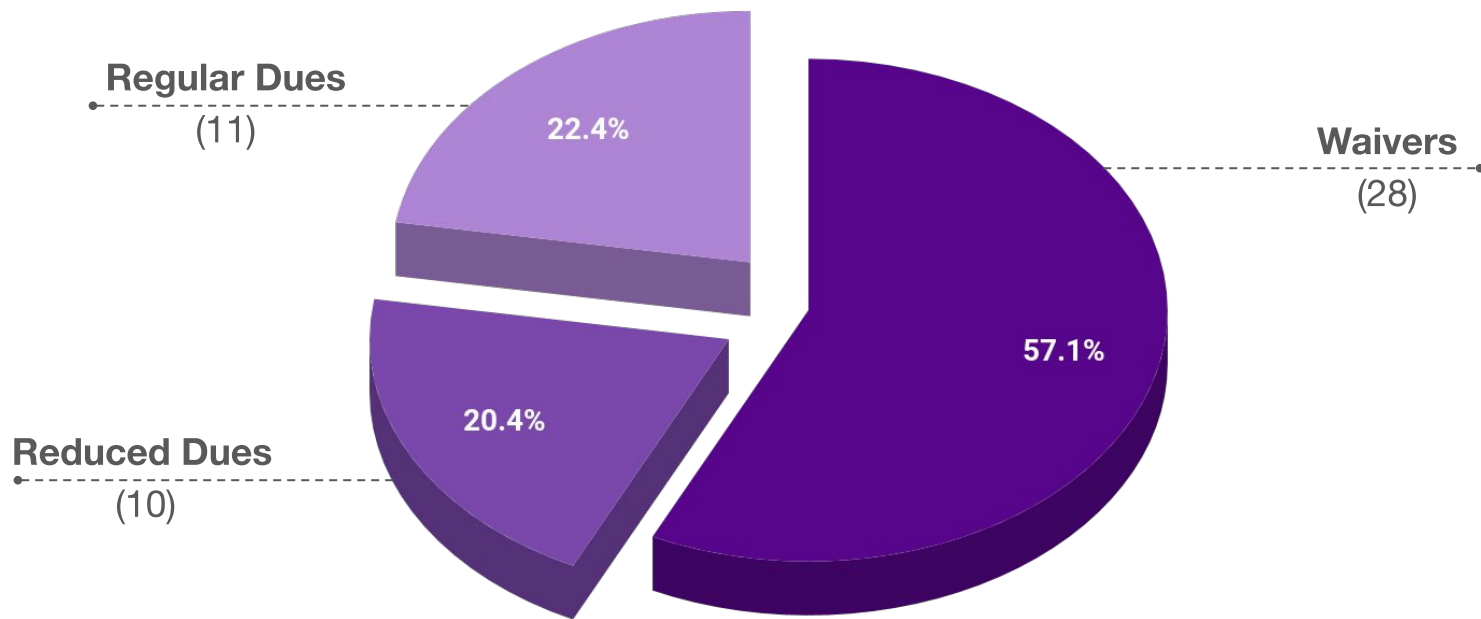

Academic Year 2020-21 FRN Dues + Waivers

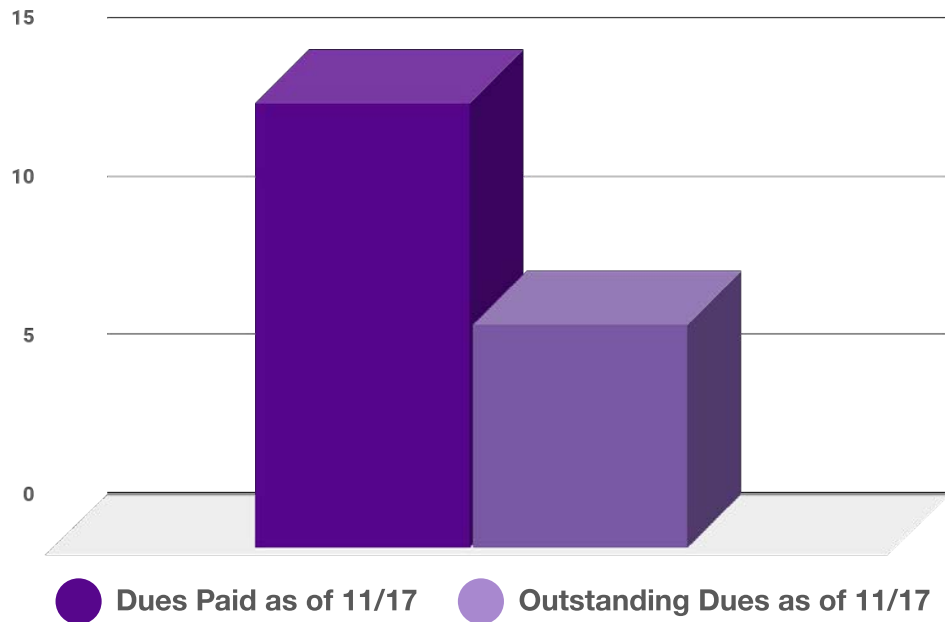
49 Institutions total - \$218k waived; \$172k anticipated

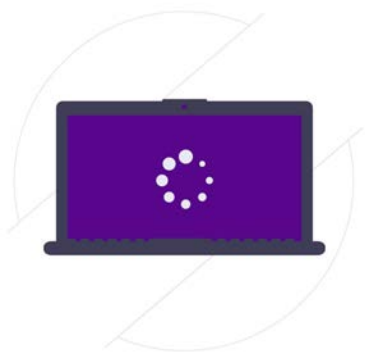

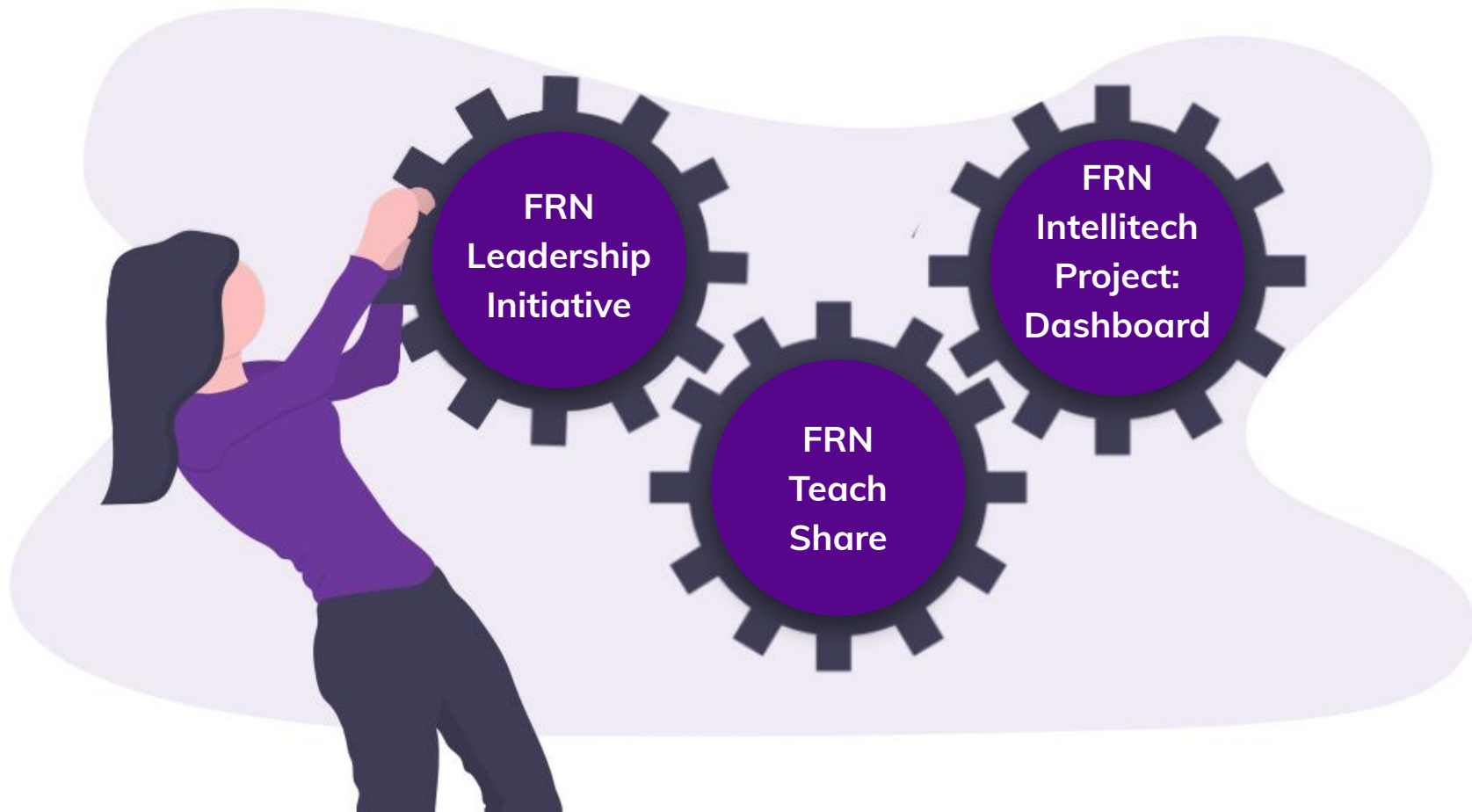

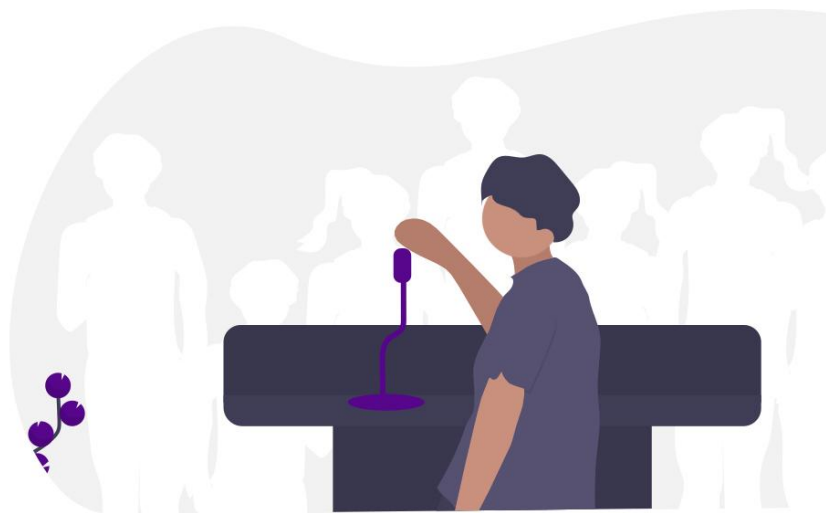
